Quality Improvement and Commissioning Peer Support Programme

As part of a range of support programmes that we offer, we are now able to deliver support and development aimed at supporting individuals within Local Authorities, CCGs and integrated care systems, who have a remit for commissioning or promoting quality in care settings.

The programme will help you:

- Keep informed of policy developments and practice insights
- Develop your approaches that are informed by evidence-based practice
- Support you to work through the operational and strategic challenges that you face
- Build a strong peer network that can help each other into the future

Adopting a blend of themed sessions and group coaching, our professional facilitators will support virtual half-day small group discussion and reflection every 6 weeks for 5 months (7 sessions in total).





Examples of some of the questions that might be posed:

- How do we build trust with providers/owners of care settings who are difficult to engage with?
- How do we get the right balance between offering positive support to care providers whilst ensuring we hold onto the monitoring and compliance?
- How might we manage closures or threats of closure better?
- What can be done to refine our paperwork demands?
- How can we help this complex sector develop new models of care and support?
- How do we involve and engage with the sector as equal partners where competition is still a key component of how the 'market' operates?
